

Speaker and Poster Presentation Guidelines

MIGRATION 2015

Oral Presentations:

- Please consult the preliminary program for schedule times
- Speakers are asked to upload their presentations prior to the session
- Duration of talks:
 - Invited Talks – typically scheduled for 45 minutes (40 minutes presentation + 5 minutes discussion)
 - Contributed Talks – typically scheduled for 25 minutes (20 minutes presentation + 5 minutes discussion)
- Please stay on time
- Powerpoint format is fully supported. Please send an email to migration2015@newmexicoconsortium.org if you have special requirements.

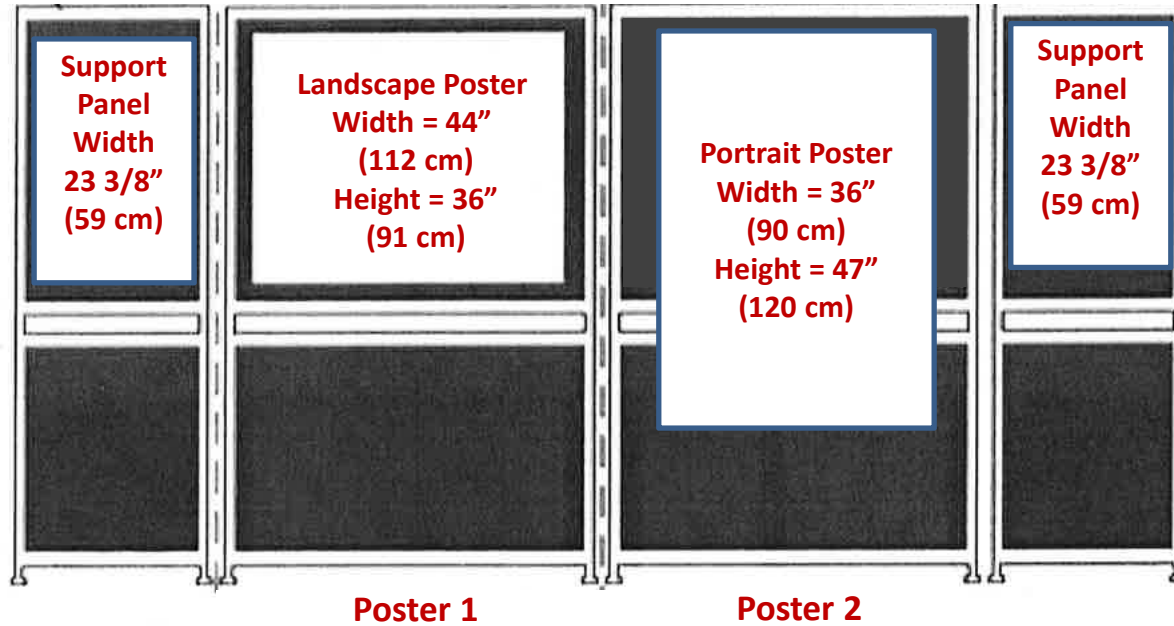
Poster Guidelines:

- Posters need to fit into a 46 7/8” (119 cm) width and 36 9/16” (93 cm) top space or 64” (162 cm) overall length (see below for details). There are two recommended approaches (at the authors discretion):
 - **Landscape style: W = 42” (107 cm); H = 36” (91 cm)**
 - **Portrait style: W = 36” (90 cm); H = 47” (120 cm) - usual/preferred style for Migration**
- Most poster locations, will also have the availability of a support panel that can be used if desired (so for example supporting information on research organization and/or data, or hanging a folder with abstract printouts).
- Sticky-backed Velcro and appropriate supplies will be provided to attach the posters.
- All posters (Monday and Tuesday session) should be in place by our noon break on Monday and should be left up through the AM coffee break on Thursday.

Poster Competition:

- A key feature of the MIGRATION conference series is our poster competition – Posters are evaluated by the steering and scientific committee members that are in attendance.
- Three posters will be recognized at our Thursday evening banquet – all posters submitted are eligible.

Recommended Size of Posters:

Landscape Design: W = 42" (107 cm); H = 36" (91 cm)

Portrait Design: W = 36" (90 cm); H = 47" (120 cm)

Use of the support panel space (at a 90° angle - see below) is optional but available
Supplies for mounting the poster will be provided (sticky-backed Velcro)
